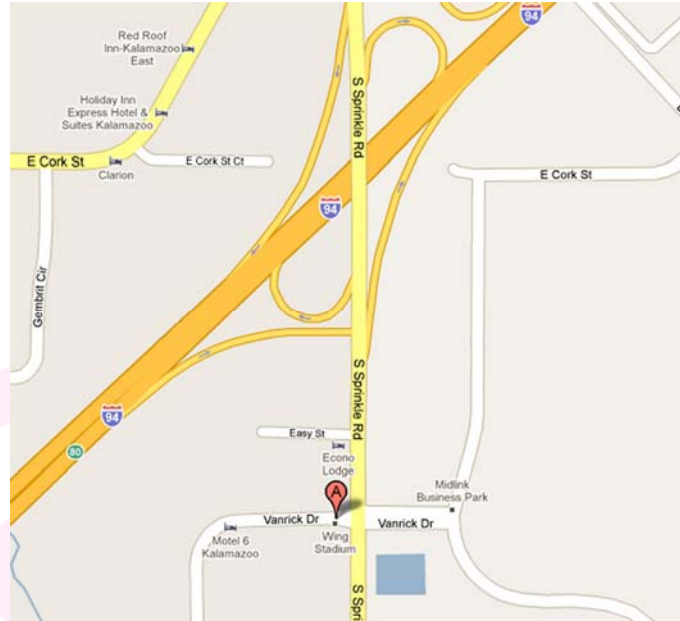

Details: This event will take place in the north parking lot at the popular Wings Stadium in Kalamazoo, MI. This event will occur rain or shine (unless an extraordinary downpour occurs). Participants are asked to bring their helmets. All participants must wear closed toed shoes. Speeds at this venue won't exceed first gear. If you are towing your car, the south lot will have plenty of room to park tow vehicles and trailers. Spectators are welcome at no charge. We will break for lunch just before 12:00pm. Lunch will be provided compliments of the club. Coolers will be on hand and water is free to everyone. Once all run groups are finished, we can begin packing up while calculations are made. Longest Day awards will follow. We'll have a great time!
