

MCVO CODE OF CONDUCT

The intention of this document is to establish clear and acceptable behavior and expectations for MCVO members. It is not intended to restrict the legal rights of anyone but rather to ensure that all members can expect to be treated equally and with reverence while enjoying the benefits of the Club.

Members are entitled to:

- Be treated impartially and with respect by the Executive Committee, Board of Directors and all other members of the Club.
- Socialize in an environment free from all forms of harassment and discrimination as defined by Federal, State and Local laws.
- Be informed and actively involved in all Club events and offerings.
- Have the right to run for office as defined by the Club By-Laws.
- Voice their opinions, requirements and suggestions to the Executive Committee.
- MCVO members are strongly encouraged to bring their Vipers to MCVO events or Events of Interest when possible. It is recognized that situations due to inclement weather, vehicle maintenance, etc. may necessitate attendance in a non-Viper vehicle. Please be aware that in those situations club members will be asked to park their non-Viper vehicles in a separate area and be positioned at the rear of a Viper caravan.

Members may not:

- Engage in excessive alcohol/illegal drug use.
- Operate their vehicle in an unsafe manner.
- Use abusive language toward another person.
- Participate in a physically threatening or violent manner toward another person.
- Commit theft or vandalism or willful destruction of club, or club member, property.
- Use unsportsmanlike conduct.

- Post complaints, allegations, negative political rhetoric, or other “dirty laundry” on the MCVO or national VOA Facebook pages.
